BACKGROUND

With the launch of the Next Generation NCLEX announced by the National Council of the State Board of Nursing, the School of Nursing is implementing an updated policy to integrate best practices of Assessment Technology Resources, LLC ("ATI") into the prelicensure programs.

PURPOSE

To develop a culture where students and faculty are empowered to improve consistency and maximize utilization of the NCLEX prep product Assessment Technology Resources, LLC ("ATI") across prelicensure programs.

APPLIES TO

Faculty and students in traditional and accelerated prelicensure programs.

POLICY STATEMENT

Students will have access to Assessment Technology Resources, LLC ("ATI"). Testing expectations, scoring, and focused review processes will adhere to the procedures identified in the student handbook and course syllabi.

ENFORCEMENT

Violations of this policy may result in appropriate disciplinary measures in accordance with University By-Laws, the School of Nursing Undergraduate handbook, and the University of Connecticut Student Code.

PROCEDURES/FORMS

Practice Test A and Practice Test B:

• Students will complete the online focused review in ATI. Minimum 2-hour Focus Review.

- Students will identify the lowest three NCLEX content areas from their comprehensive predictor practice test. Students will complete a minimum of 3 handwritten (paper and pencil/pen) Active Learning Templates chosen from their lowest scoring areas. Students can print the templates from ATI or use traditional notebook paper.
- If prompted, students will complete the ATI focus review post study quiz.
- Students will create and complete a guiz (Quiz Interface: NCLEX Board Exam/ Quiz Mode: Test) within Board Vital (number of questions based on score). Students will choose questions that relate to the 5 lowest scoring Content Areas. The quiz will be named using a naming convention that indicates the course #, their name and which ATI review. (Example: Course Number_Student Last Name_Practice Test B Review)
 - Score 0 to 65.9: 75 questions
 - Score 66-85.9: 50 questions
 - Score 86-100: 25 questions

Proctored Exam:

- Students will complete the online focused review in ATI. Minimum 2-hour Focus Review.
- Students will create and complete a quiz (Quiz Interface: NCLEX Board Exam/ Quiz ٠ Mode: Adaptive Test) within Board Vitals. Students will choose questions from ALL categories. The quiz will be named using a naming convention that indicates the course #, their name and which ATI review. (Example: Course Number Student Last Name Proctored Exam Review) •
